Electric Vehicles and Recharging: Preparing for the tipping point, Gail Broadbent BSc Dip Ed MEM MPhil, Transport policy advisor and electric vehicle expert

From the adoption of sustainable procurement policy through to specific initiatives, what has worked well and which areas have presented more of a challenge.

Building Social Impact into Your Supply Chain, Mark Daniels, Social Traders

Social traders have created a marketplace designed to enable buyers to access and be supported to buy from social enterprise suppliers. Last financial year the created \$20 million in contracts and over 300 jobs for disadvantaged people.

Government Procurement Part of the Long-term Solution to China’s National Sword, Stella Whittaker, NSW EPA

China’s strict enforcement of its National Sword policy, which restricts the types of recycled material China will accept, has highlighted the importance of strengthening local recycling markets. How can council’s use their purchasing power to support the NSW recycling industry and the ongoing collection and processing of kerbside recycling?

Case study – Shellharbour City Council, Shellharbour Civic Centre, Anne Peden, Shellharbour City Council

Anne Peden was the project officer primarily responsible for the construction of the Civic Centre. The unique design of this building will ensure it meets the highest environmental standard, including a 5-start rating from the Green Building Council of Australia. A concept of “lean, green, clean” has made sure the design has made the most of natural light and ventilation.
