A great example of successful sustainable procurement. Wollongong City council identified their sustainability objectives and implemented mandatory/weighted sustainability criteria before engaging in a tendering process for a new cleaning contractor. This project had some excellent outcomes.

Social Traders have created a marketplace designed to enable buyers to access and be supported to buy from social enterprises suppliers. Last financial year this created \$20 million in contracts and over 300 jobs for disadvantaged people.
